Course Description

Block: Mondays and Wednesdays 3:30PM-4:30PM

Grade Levels: 9-12 Pre-requisite(s): Audition

This course is made up of mixed vocal parts of Soprano (1&2), Alto (1&2), Tenor, and Bass. Students are placed in the group by approval of the director of choirs and/or completion of their show choir audition. They should reflect through their participation and efforts the discipline of learning and the pride of accomplishment. Acceptable choral discipline is required.

Each singer is expected to:

- Observe and obey all of the choral rules, regulations, and consequences (see attached)
- Enter an exit the rehearsal area in a disciplined and appropriate manner
- Participate in all warm up areas (breathing, physical, and vocal)
- Participate and respond with consistent and acceptable rehearsal effort and attitude
- Participate in all required concerts and extra rehearsals
- Maintain healthy vocal standards

Attendance

In a performing ensemble, it is so important to show up. You have three absences (excused or unexcused). On your fourth absence, you will receive a dismissal letter to inform you of your termination from show choir. Three tardies equal an absence. Absences, tardies, and early leave from dress rehearsal or performance is absolutely unacceptable and will result in show choir termination. Any time you will be absent, email Mrs. Bradford BEFORE rehearsal.

Show Choir Costumes

Each student will be responsible for rounding up some of your own costume items. It should be items that you already have around your house OR that you can find super cheap at a thrift store. Girls, you are also required to purchase tan character shoes. You can find them online. DO NOT wait until the last minute to get these items. Guys, you need to purchase black, closed toe, comfortable dress shoes to dance in. If you have any concerns, email Mrs. Bradford.

REHEARSAL AREA RULES FOR SHOW CHOIR

- 1. Be kind to everyone.
- 2. Participate in all warm ups (breathing, physical, and vocal) in an appropriate manner.
- 3. Sit/Stand in your designated area. Remember your spot for each song.
- 4. Only water bottles allowed in rehearsal..
- 5. Absolutely NO cell phones out during rehearsal unless instructed.
- 6. No one will be allowed in the chorus room during rehearsal that IS NOT a member of the show choir program. (No parents, siblings, other students, etc.)
- 7. Respect the director, the members, and the property of MSHS Performing Arts Program.

Consequences

Failure to follow the above rules will immediately affect your audition for next year as well as possible dismissal from the MSHS choral and/or show choir programs.

Show Choir Fees

• Membership Fee: Each member of the chorus must pay a \$75.00 fee to join. This fee pays for music, equipment, sets, costume rental, special effects, etc. Member fees are due by October 1. All fees must be paid for online. You can find the link on the high school website under the category "MSPA" <u>Students cannot perform if they have not paid the fee.</u> This must be paid online via My School Bucks.

Mandatory Fundraisers

• Advertisements: Each member is required to sell (2) advertisements for the ad slideshow that will roll at the beginning, intermission, and end of the show. This can be business ads, personal ads, menus, etc. If you choose not to sell the ads, you will be responsible for paying the fair share. Each ad is \$25.00. This must be paid online via My School Bucks. (You will notice that in MSB, your ads are combined with your fee for your convenience [\$125]).

Season Passes

Season passes are available in 2 options:

- MSPA 2024-2025 Premier Season Pass: Contains one ticket for unlimited performances per show, plus you get to pick your seat ahead of time, for the Muscle Shoals Performing Arts Season for \$130.
